MANAGER'S REPORT May 2023

I. DISTRICT PROJECTS:

1. System Status and Updates:

- a. Towers have been full and NO major interruptions in service since 07/08/22.
- b. Tower cleanings and clear-well cleanings complete.

2. Future Plant and Water System Improvements – DWSRF Loan Program:

3. Tulsa Pump Station:

- a. Generator installed and operable. Transfer switch scheduled sometime in 2023.
- b. New Pump and Motor (Pump #4) installed in an empty position leaving Tulsa Pump with 4 operable pumps and motors.
- c. Major piping repair. Modifications, and fuel tank shed complete.
- d. Stone Canyon Tower shut down and piping leak repair complete.

4. East Foyil and Bushyhead Water Line Project:

- a. Bushyhead: S. 4210 Rd., E. 394 Rd., & E. 395 Rd., total of ~6,570 lf, serving ~8 residences
- b. Bushvhead: S. 4218 Rd., E. 390 Rd., total of ~3,930 lf, looping and removing 3 dead ends.
- c. East Foyil: S. 4240 Rd., total of 3,030 lf, pump station, serving ~15 residences.
- d. East Foyil: S. 4215 Rd., total of 4,104 lf, pump station, serving ~10 residences.
- e. Estimated total project cost of \$954,000.
- f. Rogers County ARPA of \$238,475.00, CDBG of \$476,950.00, and District of \$237,575
- g. Phase I currently out for bids.
- h. Anticipate awarding the bid at June Board Meeting
- i. Anticipate bidding Phase II (Items 'b' through 'd') in June 2024

5. Tacora Water Plant:

- a. Spare Actiflo motors, gearboxes, paddles, etc. have all been delivered.
- b. Order placed for new and/or spare: computers, VFDs, chemical pumps, PLCs, pumps, motors, valve actuators, new high service pump, motor, and VFD, etc.
- c. Construction underway on equalization through between filters and for future expansion.
- d. Filter repairs currently underway.
- e. Possible GAC media replacement still pending.

6. 2023 Keetonville Supply Line Project:

- a. Project consisting of 1,187 lf of 14" HDPE water line and 642 lf of 24" HDPE bore and casing.
- b. Bid Awarded to Drill-Rite, Inc., of Salina OK, in the amount of \$695,007.00
- c. Agreements executed and Notice to Proceed issued 03/10/23.
- d. Construction to begin in the Summer 2023 and scheduled to complete in the Fall 2023.

7. FAA Pump Station Upgrade Project:

- a. New pumps, controls, VFDs, and generator
- b. Installation by District Staff and Kellogg Engineering

8. Tacora and Keetonville Water Tower Project:

- a. Proposed Tacora 2.0 Million Gallon Water Tower
- b. Proposed Keetonville 2.0 Million Gallon Water Tower
- c. Phase I of Tacora Hills 18" Water Line, ~1,700 lf along SH-88 from Tower site to Spillway

 - a. Extension of Bluffs private gated addition west of Patriot Club House
 - b. All water lines to 6" HDPE and 2" HDPE water lines
 - a. Kellogg Engineering is the project engineer.
 - b. Construction Plans at ODEQ for permitting.
